### NOTICE OF FIRST MODIFICATIONS TO PROPOSED GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 11135 ET SEQ. REGULATIONS

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Civil Rights Council (Council) is providing notice of the first set of modifications to proposed Government Code Section 11135 et seq. Regulations, of Title 2 of the California Code of Regulations covering nondiscrimination in state-supported programs and activities. These changes are attached and made in response to written comments regarding the proposed regulations received during the initial 45-day public comment period that ended on April 3, 2023. Text proposed to be added for this 15-day comment period is displayed in double underline and yellow highlighting. Text proposed to be deleted for this 15-day comment period is displayed in double strikethrough and blue highlighting.
